Subject: OSHA's Revised Beryllium Standard

Dear Valued Customer:

Thank you for your interest in the beryllium content in Barton garnet. Recent test data has validated Barton's position that our garnet materials do not contain beryllium above regulated levels (the OSHA beryllium standard regulates materials containing beryllium above 0.1%). Test data demonstrates that beryllium levels in Barton's garnet are *non-detectable*; results were below EPA Method 6010C/3050B detection capabilities. The Barton garnet beryllium test data is available upon request.
