RoHS Compliance Letter

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is in response to your concerns regarding EU directives 2002/95/EC on the Restrictions on the use of certain Hazardous Substances, (RoHS) and 2002/96/EC, Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment, (WEEE) which address the possible presence of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls, polybrominated diphenyl esters, CFCs, PCBs and PCTs in Barton's garnet products. None of these substances are intentionally or knowingly used in the manufacturing of Barton's garnet products. We have no reason to believe that any of these substances are created by our manufacturing process. As a result, we do not expect these substances to be detectable in our product and therefore we do not specify or test for a maximum level of any of these substances.

Since we do not routinely monitor for these, we can only certify that we do not intentionally or knowingly add or use the substances listed above.
